Framework	Individual Contact Tracing	Group Tracing
Students with COVID-19	Isolate per general LAC DPH guidance ¹	Isolate per general LAC DPH guidance ¹
Students exposed to someone at school with COVID-19	Identify <u>individuals</u> who were within 6 feet for at least 15 minutes (within 24 hours) of someone at school with COVID-19 during their infectious period	Identify <u>groups</u> who shared the same indoor airspace at school for at least 15 minutes (within 24 hours) of someone with COVID-19 during their infectious period
Action in the 10 days ² after last exposure	Asymptomatic students who are NOT fully vaccinated ⁴ and <u>DID NOT</u> have a mask-on-mask school exposure	Quarantine per general LAC DPH guidance³
	Asymptomatic students who are not fully vaccinated ⁴ and <u>DID</u> have mask-on-mask school exposure	Quarantine per general LAC DPH guidance³ May remain in school under modified quarantine if they: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Test at least once on or around Day 5² unless they had COVID-19 in the past 90 days. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ If resources are available, test twice, preferably immediately after notification of exposure and on or around Day 5. • Wear a highly protective mask.⁵ • Monitor for symptoms.⁶ • May participate in school sports and extracurricular activities.
	Asymptomatic students who are fully vaccinated ⁴ OR had a positive COVID-19 test in the past 90 days	Exempt from quarantine and testing <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wear a highly protective mask.⁵ • Monitor for symptoms.⁶ • If resources are available, fully vaccinated students should test once between Days 3-5.²
Group Action for all three categories of exposed students without symptoms: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Remain in school • Test once between Days 3-5² unless they had COVID-19 in the past 90 days. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Students who are not fully vaccinated⁴ should be prioritized for testing. • Wear a highly protective mask.⁵ • Monitor for symptoms.⁶ • May participate in school sports and extracurricular activities

⁶ If [symptomatic or symptoms](#) develop, remain at home and get tested. If positive, isolate per general LAC DPH guidance.¹ If negative, stay home until fever free for 24 hours and improved symptoms.
