Students with COVID-19

Students exposed to someone at school with COVID-19

Group Tracing

Isolate per general LAC DPH guidance¹

Identify groups who shared the same indoor airspace at school for at least 15 minutes (within 24 hours) of someone with COVID-19

Group Action for all three categories of exposed students without symptoms:

- Remain in school
- Get tested once
 - Test preferably between Days 3-5² where possible
 - Students who are not fully vaccinated⁴ are required to test at least once weekly.
 - Other student groups are recommended to test once except for students who had a positive COVID-19 test in the past 90 days.
- Students can participate in sports and extracurricular activities if tested
- Upgrade to well-fitted mask⁵; required to wear indoors & outdoors
- Monitor for symptoms⁶

- 2 Day 0 is the last date of exposure to the infected person
- 5 Students should wear a non-cloth mask of multiple layers of non-woven material with a nose wire.
- 6 If symptomatic or symptoms develop, remain at home and get tested. If positive, isolate per general LACDPH guidance. If negative, stay home until fever free for 24 hours and improved symptoms.
