DISTINGUISHED AWARDS AND ACCREDITATIONS

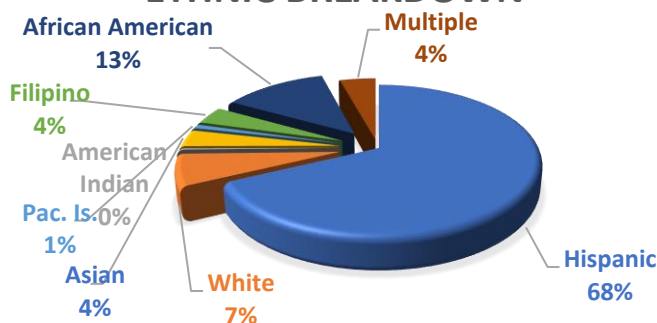

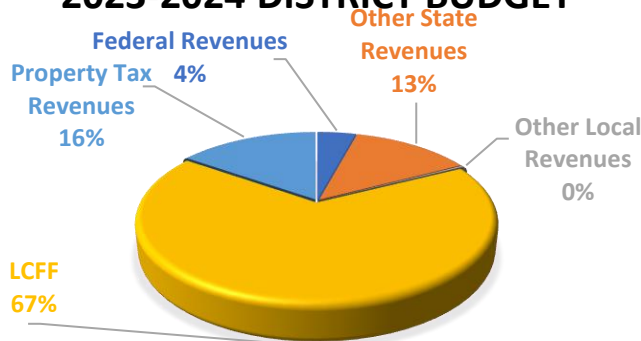
